<p>Why is this important to keep people safe?</p> <p>The virus can live for more than 24 hours in indoor environments.</p> <p>Hand washing or using sanitizer can reduce the risk of catching or passing on the virus.</p>	<p>Why is this important to keep people safe?</p> <p>Coronavirus is carried in the air by tiny respiratory droplets that carry the virus.</p> <p>Face coverings reduce the spread of droplets.</p>	<p>Why is this important to keep people safe?</p> <p>Transmission of the virus is most likely to happen within 2 metres.</p> <p>Making space has a powerful impact when it comes to containing the spread.</p>
<p>What else can you do to help?</p> <p>Consider making hand sanitiser available at the entrance to the store for customers, as well as between colleague and customer facing areas of the store.</p>	<p>What else can you do to help?</p> <p>If you're able to, giving face coverings away to customers that have forgotten them is an effective way of reducing the risk of confrontation.</p>	<p>What else can you do to help?</p> <p>In addition to signage and reminders in-store, limit the number of customers at any one time so that everyone is able to keep a safe distance apart.</p>
